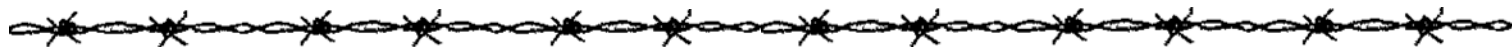

Angus Influence Female Sale

JC Livestock Sales -- Junction City, KS -- April 12, 2008 at 1:00 pm



The Kansas Angus Association is proud to cooperate with the Langvardts at JC Livestock Sales to sponsor the annual Angus Influence Female Sale each spring. We invite you to participate in this special event at the Junction City Livestock Sale facility.

This sale is historically an excellent place to buy high-quality Angus-based females. If you are interested in consigning cattle to this sale, please complete the attached consignment form and send -or fax it to the address at the bottom of the form. The earlier we receive your consignments, the better we can advertise them. The information provided on the form will be used to advertise your cattle, as well as compile a data sheet to be available to buyers.

Consignment Criteria and Delivery Times

To insure the quality of the cattle offered at this sale, the following guidelines have been established:

1. Females must meet Certified Angus Beef live specifications: be predominately black hided (although black white faces and/or "baldies" are accepted); have typical beef-type conformation (no visible dairy influence); and be without long floppy ear and hump (no visible Brahman influence).
2. Maximum Age - No older than eight years old. The cattle may be mouthed by the official veterinarian at JC Livestock Sales.
3. All females must be preg checked and blood tested. Cattle will be preg checked and bled by JC Livestock Sales official veterinarian. Calving dates provided are guaranteed by the seller. Open females are guaranteed by the seller to be open, and will be preg checked if there are any concerns.
4. Minimum consignments of 5 head will be accepted, with no maximum number. Exceptions at the descretion of the sale staff. Cattle will be sorted by the sale staff for optimum sale presentation.
5. **The sale barn will accept delivery of the cattle any time starting Friday, April 11. The cattle must be delivered by 10:00 am Saturday, April 12. This will give the veterinarian time to complete all needed work and the buyers a chance to see your cattle.**

Selling Fees

Cost will be the regular sale barn expense plus \$5/head, or \$6/pair, commission for the Kansas Angus Association to cover promotion and advertising. Advertising will be placed in the *Grass & Grain, Farm Talk*, Kansas Angus Association Internet listing, and other outlets as determined by the sale staff.

The sale barn cost will be 2% for Bred Cows & Heifers, Cow/calf Pairs; and Open Heifers; plus a \$1 yardage fee; \$0.22 health inspection fee; \$.001/\$1 selling price insurance charge per head. When females are blood typed and preg checked by the sale barn veterinarian the fee is \$4.50; mouthing is \$1. There will be a \$10 charge for "No Sale" animals, \$5 to go to JC Livestock and \$5 to the KAA. Feed costs at the sale barn are \$4/bale for hay and \$0.08/lb for grain.

Entry Information

Please complete the attached consignment form as you would like it to appear on the handout sheet that will be available at the sale and mailed upon request. Please note that it will be your responsibility as seller to make sure the information you report is accurate. The Kansas Angus Association provides this information as a service and is not liable for its accuracy. Please return the form by March 28 for advertising. The earlier we receive your consignment, the better we can advertise your cattle. Consignments will be accepted until April 12, if space allows.

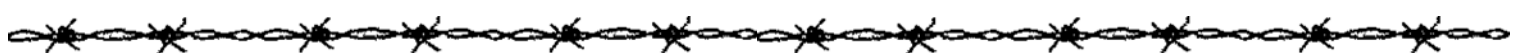
